DURABLE ASSETS CREATED DURING THE LAST TWO YEARS

The NSS unit of Gulabrao Patil Homoeopathic Medical College, conducted different activities in different villages in the last two years which is as follows:-

In the social camp villages and adopted villages the durable assets / achievements during this period are being described here.

In the village Ankali, Juni Dhamni, Mhaisal and Vijaynagar people were not aware about the treatment of Homoeopathy. Only about 10% people were knowing and 5% people were taking treatment. But after our social service camp Homoeopathic awareness was created and Homoeopathic treatment camp was conducted. Now 70% peoples in Karnal, 78% in Nandre, 68% in Bhamnoli and 80% in Vijaynagar are knowing about Homoeopathy and experiencing the cure by Homoeopathic medicine.

After social service camp every weekly we visit these villages and provide them free of cost Homoeopathic treatment and community awareness. Which is successfully done and it is beneficial to the villagers.

In 2019, in Sangli district COVID -19 pandemic occurred. People of different villages were afraid of the same. During that time our NSS volunteers performed the deities in fever clinc, screening covid patients and immune boosters arsenic alb 200 dstribution and home quarantine heatht check up and street play and created awareness about covid -19 and sensitive slum areas of Miraj city and villages like Haripur, Malgaon, Ankali, Juni Dhamni, Sangli, Kupwad, Mhaisal Nandre, karnal. They gave information and preventive measures for COVID-19. Our college NSS unit published 10,000 COVID-19 awareness pamphlets and distributed it in sensitive areas of Sangli district. It was declared by the Sangli District Health Department that our NSS volunteers created awareness and gave information to more than 35,000 peoples. This was

the active role played by our unit and appreciated by the Health Department of Sangli District.

In village of Ankali and Vijaynagar more than 70% households have constructed sanitary latrines and promoted Grampanchayat to built common latrines in villages. They have built more than 12 latrines for the villagers promoting to reach 100%.

In all villages during Social Service Camp we conduct the survey for **Health – Education – Hygiene** with this we understand the village problems relating to health and hygiene and we arrange health programmes accordingly. After assessing the health status of the families and need of health service required is understood.

In every social camp we create the awareness of "Ideal Villages" and show them the winners of President of India awards. The Sarpanch and Grampanchayat members and villagers, involving and status of their village now stands to become ideal village and deficits and things to do in their village. We guide them on last day of our camp; showing the Audio-video presentation of Ralegansiddhi and Heware Bazar, just to inspire the villagers to actively involve in the National and State level health programmes and other programmes also. This was a new idea implemented by our NSS programme officer Dr. Jineshwar Yaligouda after his visit to Ralegansiddhi and Heware Bazar.

In Arjunwad Camp Lions Hospital operated 26 patients for cataract more than 55 peoples were provided spectacles.

3) <u>COVID -19 Pandemic - COVID WARRIORS as a social responsible</u> worker.

COVID -19 pandemic we worked in screening the patients at FEVER CLINIC and distribution of Arsenic Alb 200 as a immune boosters by conducting free camps and covid-19 helping center at sangli district people and helping and in coordination with sanglimiraj-kupwad corporation PHC by the commissioners Shri Nitin Kapadnis advice and chairman PRITHVIRAJ PATIL founder chairman GPHMC active initiative checked the COVID -19 HOME QURANTINE POSITIVE patients health check up done about 4582 patients also I worked as coordinator for covid helping center about bed vacancy and oxygen bed vacancy and free ambulance facilities to home to hospital and hospital to home and fever clinics to identify the risk or covid carriers and travelling history people check up and distribution of immune boosters Arsenic Alb 200 and distribution of sanitizers and face masks to health workers and police workers and media people and swachata worker and asha workers and home to home visit to check up the covid-19 positive home quarantine patients care taken by providing free medicines and health advice and helped during emergencies of COVID-19 pandemic at sangli district awarded as COVID WARRIORER and felicitated by state helth minister DR RAJENDR YADRAWNKAR PATIL Minister of Maharashtra state.
