The Institution ensures implementation of its stated Code of Ethics for research.

### Norms and Guidelines for Research -

**Principle of essentiality** whereby after due consideration of all alternatives in the light of existing knowledge, the use of human participants is considered to be essential for the proposed research. This should be duly vetted by an ethics committee (EC) independent of the proposed research.

**Principle of voluntaries** whereby respect for the right of the participant to agree or not to agree to participate in research, or to withdraw from research at any time, is paramount. The informed consent process ensures that participants' rights are safeguarded.

**Principle of non-exploitation** whereby research participants are equitably selected so that the benefits and burdens of the research are distributed fairly and without arbitrariness or discrimination. Sufficient safeguards to protect vulnerable groups should be ensured.

**Principle of social responsibility** whereby the research is planned and conducted so as to avoid creation or deepening of social and historic divisions or in any way disturb social harmony in community relationships.

Principle of ensuring privacy and confidentiality whereby to maintain privacy of the potential participant, her/his identity and records are kept confidential and access is limited to only those authorized. However, under certain circumstances (suicidal ideation, homicidal tendency, HIV positive status, when required by court of law etc.) privacy of the information can be breached in consultation with the EC for valid scientific or legal reasons as the right to life of an individual supersedes the right to privacy of the research participant.

**Principle of risk minimization** whereby due care is taken by all stakeholders (including but not limited to researchers, EC, sponsors, regulators) at all stages of the research to ensure that the risks are minimized and appropriate care and compensation is given if any harm occurs.

**Principle of professional competence** whereby the research is planned, conducted, evaluated and monitored throughout by persons who are competent and have the appropriate and relevant qualification, experience and/or training.

**Principle of maximization of benefit** whereby due care is taken to design and conduct the research in such a way as to directly or indirectly maximize the benefits to the research participants and/or to the society.

**Principle of institutional arrangements** whereby institutions where the research is being conducted, have policies for appropriate research governance and take the responsibility to facilitate research by providing required infrastructure, manpower, funds and training opportunities.

Principle of transparency and accountability whereby the research plan and outcomes emanating from the research are brought into the public domain through registries, reports and scientific and other publications while safeguarding the right to privacy of the participants. Stakeholders involved in research should disclose any existing conflict of interest and manage it appropriately. The research should be conducted in a fair, honest, impartial and transparent manner to guarantee accountability. Related records, data and notes should be retained for the required period for possible external scrutiny/ audit.

**Principle of totality of responsibility** whereby all stakeholders involved in research are responsible for their actions. The professional, social and moral responsibilities compliant with ethical guidelines and related regulations are binding on all stakeholders directly or indirectly.

**Principle of environmental protection** whereby researchers are accountable for ensuring protection of the environment and resources at all stages of the research, in compliance with existing guidelines and regulations.

### **ETHICAL APPROVAL**

As per Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR), an EC can give one of the following decision-

- Approved with or without suggestions or comments;
- Revision with minor modifications/amendments approval is given after examination by the Member Secretary or expedited review, as the case may be
- Revision with major modifications for re submission this will be placed before the full committee for reconsideration for approval; or
- Not approved (or termination/revoking of permission if applicable) clearly defined reasons must be given for not approving/terminating/revoking of permission.

### COMPLIANCE REGARDING STANDARDS AND PROCEDURES OF RESEARCH

### MANAGING VARIOUS RESEARCH PROJECTS

All the Researchers should be familiarize themselves with the various terms and conditions also Norms and Guidelines of ICMR and CCRH while conducting various Research Projects.

### MENTORING AND SUERVISION FOR RESEACH PROJECTS -

Principal investigators, supervisors and Guide must mentor their team members and provide specific guidance to them. Every Researcher must ensure that all the persons involved in the conduct of research are adequately trained and perform their responsibilities competently.

### HONESTY -

Every Researcher must ensure that all the data obtained from research is correct and exactly accurate. For variations the researcher must take appropriate steps to correct or retract the information in all outlets where it has appeared. Researchers must avoid any bias in interpreting results.

### CONFLICT OF INTEREST

As per ICMR Conflict of interest (COI) is a set of conditions where professional judgement concerning a primary interest such as participants welfare or the validity of research tends to be unduly influenced by a secondary interest, financial or non-financial (personal, academic or political). COI can be at the level of researchers, EC members, institutions or sponsors. If COI is inherent in the research, it is important to declare this at the outset and establish appropriate mechanisms to manage it.

### INFORMED CONSENT

As per ICMR Informed consent protects the individual's autonomy to freely choose whether or not to participate in the research. The process involves three components – providing relevant information to potential participants, ensuring the information is comprehended by them and assuring voluntaries of participation.

Informed consent should explain medical terminology in simple terms and be in a language that the participant understands. The informed consent process ensures that participants' rights are safeguarded.

### DATA MANAGEMENT

All Researchers must have to keep clear and accurate records of research procedures results obtained throughout their work, including interim results. Data generated in the course of research work must be kept in proper format specifically in electronic formats.

### **PUBILCTION PRACTICE**

All the publications must be through peer-reviewed journals, books, presentations, or other suitable media platforms .

### RESEARCH MISCONDUCT

As per ICMR, research misconduct involves fabrication, falsification and plagiarism of data which are serious issues both nationally and internationally.

Research misconduct, if suspected, needs to be investigated. An institution must investigate all allegations of misconduct, as present or future participant's lives may be endangered if facts are not presented accurately. Such investigations must be done in a timely, fair and transparent manner and the results should be made available in the public domain.

It is important to establish institutional mechanisms for protection of both the whistle blower and the person accused of research misconduct. This information must be kept confidential.

### **Plagiarism**

Plagiarism Is one of the Research misconduct

Plagiarism is the "wrongful appropriation" and "stealing and publication" of another paper or another author's "language, thoughts, ideas, or expressions" and the representation of them as one's own original work or duplicating one's own publication (self plagiarism).

Hence, the institute has formed guidelines & Code of ethics for Research as follows:

- 1. Before commencement of Research work/project clearance is must from Institutional Ethical Committee. [Synonyms of commencement : Beginning, start, opening, induct, instate, admit].
- 2. Research work in form of paper/ projects done by the faculty members / students should go through the process of plagiarism & the plagiarism report should be produced in front of the Institutional ethical committee.
- 3. Proper citation & acknowledgement must be provided when the original work or contents or references are copied from other sources.
- 4. All form of Research & dissertation work done in institution by faculty members & students should be monitored by the team of experts to ensure originality.
- 5. Code of ethics to check plagiarism is implemented by conducting regular review meeting.
- 6. Code of ethics should be strictly followed / imposed to avoid plagiarism & malpractice in order to ensure honesty & transparency in all Research activities including projects & dissertations.
